Competition:

All items, from the 54th edition of the CWA Cook Book (75th anniversary.)

7 (seven) distinct items from the Jams, Jellies, Marmalades, and Preserves, Chutneys, Pickles, Sauces, and Relishes, Pages 289 to 318. Lemon Butter page 254 and Passionfruit Butter. Page 256. Labelled, stating the recipe page, e.g. Fig Jam (No.3) from page 290.

Bottles to be of uniform size (not great big jars) other than the sauce bottles.

Presented in a basket, box or on a tray. No brand names on lids, lids could be covered with contact paper or painted.

4ply yarn (not wool), so it can be easily washed.

Layette to comprise of cardigan with V neck, beanie and leggings.

Members, the pattern is available from Head office.

Their request this year is clothes for the calico hospital doll.

Pattern sheets are available from Head Office.

For the girls: a dress, underpants (like shorts) then a little top to go with shorts, and pyjamas.

For the boys: board shorts (bright colours), pants, shirt and pyjamas.

Place each sets in a small material bag.

NURSING HOMES: For display only.

Stable Table Fiddle Rug.

This cover fits over a stable table, which sits on the patients knees and has all bits and pieces to feel, touch and play with. Ref Page 5 (Sep /Oct magazine)

Size 43cm across x 34cm down, sew a 8 cm wide strip of material around the edge which allows for a casing that the elastic is threaded through.
