BURSARY, SCHOLARSHIP AND FUND GUIDELINES

CWA BURSARY – CWA MEMBERS

- BURSARY:** The number of bursaries and the amount to be awarded are determined by State Management Committee with consideration of the educational course requested and the funds available in that year.
- At least one CWA member bursary shall be awarded each year for that year's study. Recipients are eligible to apply in subsequent years.
- ELIGIBILITY:** The applicant must be a member of CWA of WA (Inc) and must have a record of at least five years' membership (not necessarily consecutive).
- CRITERIA:** The application shall demonstrate that some financial assistance will make enrolment in the course possible.
- The application shall demonstrate the benefit of the course to the applicant, to CWA and the community.
- AMOUNT:** Varies with request – may be applied to: course fees, books, accommodation, travel – full details must be supplied.
- DURATION:** One year or one short course only (applicant may reapply)
- CLOSING DATE:** Applications are considered at the November meeting of State Management Committee and should be received at State Office by **30 September** in any given year.
- NOTIFICATION:** All applicants will be notified of the outcome and the names of recipients will be published in *The Countrywoman of Western Australia*.
