## BURSARY, SCHOLARSHIP AND FUND GUIDELINES

### **CWA BURSARY – SECONDARY EDUCATION** **(Sir James Mitchell Education and Welfare Fund)**

- BURSARY:** Given for special requirements: books, uniforms, sporting gear, music lessons, extra coaching – academic or sport.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Available only to children and grandchildren of members. Applicants may re-apply each year.
- Students commencing Years 7, 8, 9, 10
  - Students commencing Years 11 and 12
- CRITERIA:**
1. Student endeavour
  2. Community involvement
  3. Financial need
- Recommendations/citations and supporting documents relating to the criteria must be included i.e. School Principal (if appropriate).
- AMOUNT:** Determined each year by State Management Committee.
- CLOSING DATE:** Applications are to be received at State Office by **30 September** in any given year.
- NOTIFICATION:** All applicants will be notified of the outcome and the names of recipients of a CWA bursary will be published in *The Countrywoman of Western Australia*
