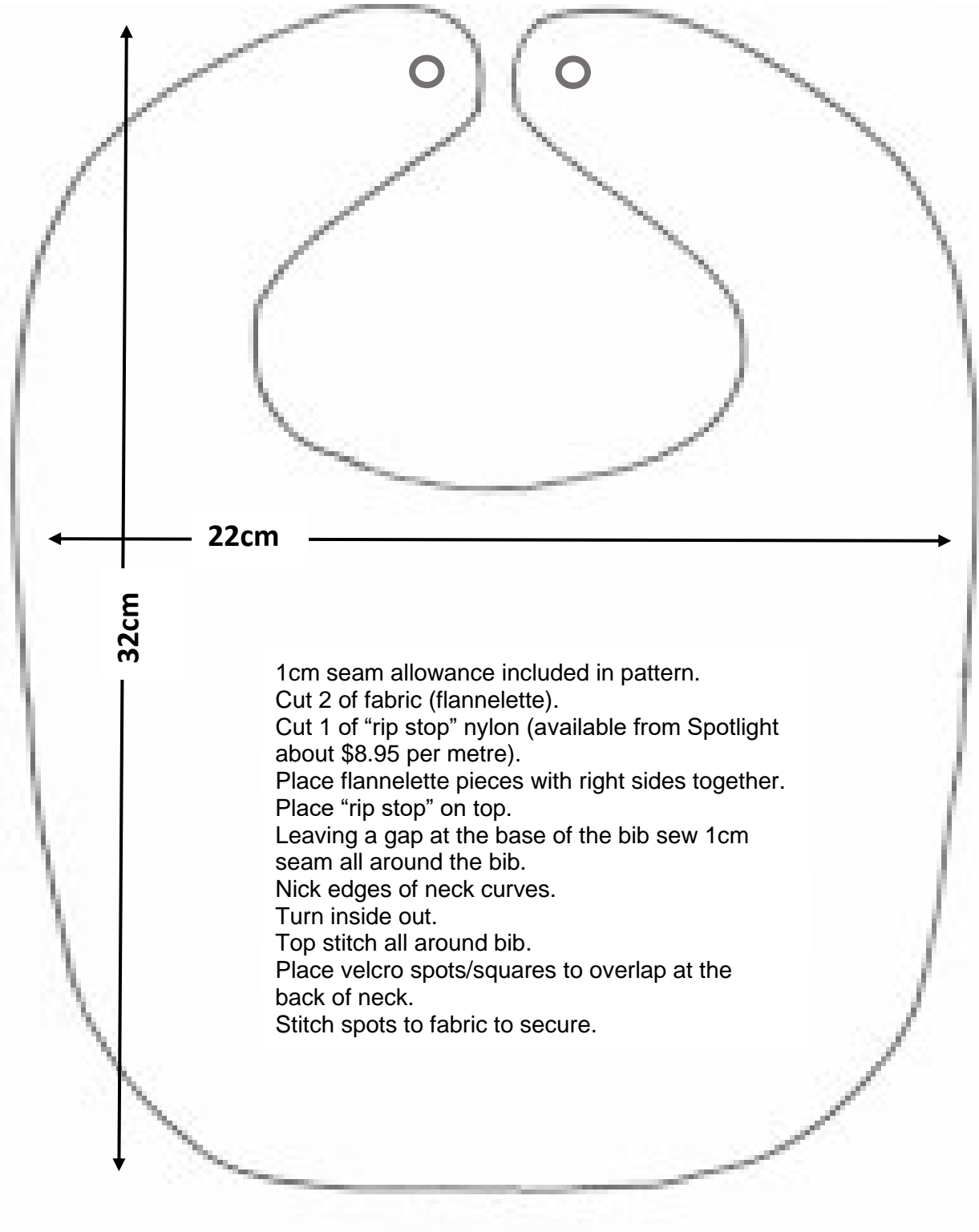




## Instructions: BIB

(Project via CWA of WA Community Co-ordinator (Jan 2020))

Note: if 6 months have passed since the above date, please check that this item is still required before you begin.



1cm seam allowance included in pattern.

Cut 2 of fabric (flannelette).

Cut 1 of "rip stop" nylon (available from Spotlight about \$8.95 per metre).

Place flannelette pieces with right sides together.

Place "rip stop" on top.

Leaving a gap at the base of the bib sew 1cm seam all around the bib.

Nick edges of neck curves.

Turn inside out.

Top stitch all around bib.

Place velcro spots/squares to overlap at the back of neck.

Stitch spots to fabric to secure.
