



Instructions: CAP BEANIE (for both Premmies and Perinatal loss)

(Project via CWA of WA Community Co-ordinator (Jan 2020))

Note: if 6 months have passed since the above date, please check that this item is still required before you begin.

Cap Beanie: to fit Premmie babies

Using 3 ¼ needles and 4ply synthetic yarn (e.g. nylon or acrylic) cast on 100 stitches

Rib K1, P1

Stocking stitch until work measures 7cm

Shape crown

K1 *K6, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl

K1, *K5, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl

K1, *K4, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl

K1, *K3, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl

K1, *K2, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl

K1, * K1, K2 tog. Repeat from * to end of row

Purl 2 tog to end of row. Break yarn, thread through remaining stitches.

Pull up and fasten. Join back seam.

Makes a 12cm deep cap.



Cap Beanie (tiny): for Perinatal loss

Using 3 ¼ needles and 4ply synthetic yarn (e.g. nylon or acrylic) cast on 40 stitches

Knit 6 rows Rib K1, P1

Knit 8 rows in stocking stitch

Follow above decreasing layout (50 stitches also works)

Makes cap about 7cm deep
