CWA SECONDARY EDUCATION APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The evaluating committee needs to have as much information as possible to make a fair and informed decision. Applicants should provide FULL details of their eligibility by addressing the 3 (three) criteria as shown below.

Funds are provided by the CWA Sir James Mitchell Fund.

BURSARY: Given for special requirements: books, uniforms, sporting gear, music lessons, extra coaching – academic or sport.

ELIGIBILITY: Available **only to children and grandchildren (male or female) of CWA of WA current financial members.** Applicants may re-apply each year.

- Lower Secondary: Students commencing Years 7, 8, 9, 10
- Upper Secondary: Students commencing Years 11 and 12

CRITERIA: **Applicants must:**

- 1.** Demonstrate financial need. (Please provide documentary evidence e.g. Centrelink Income Statement, Bank Statements, letter from financial institution etc.)
- 2.** Demonstrate student endeavour and achievements. (Provide letters from the school principal and / or school teachers as well as extracts of current school reports/certificates).
- 3.** Demonstrate local community involvement. (Provide letters of support from community groups).

AMOUNT: Determined each year by the CWA of WA Board.

DURATION: One year or one short course only (applicant may reapply)

CLOSING DATE: Applications must be received at State Office by **30 September** in any given year. Application form and required documents to be returned to:
