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COMMUNITY PROJECT GRANT

*Guidelines

1. A Branch of CWA of WA may apply for funding for a community project in their community.
2. A Branch of CWA of WA may also apply for small renovations or projects for their CWA Centre*.
3. Application to be submitted by 31st May each year on an application form which is available from the Association.
4. No CWA branch can apply again for a period of 5 years once it has been successful.
5. All Community Project Grants shall be acknowledged as an Association project in an appropriate manner.
6. Successful applicants will be required to provide evidence of acquittal as requested.
7. State Management Committee to select and allocate funds to a suitable project, but no more than two in any one year to a total of \$10,000. The Grant/s shall be paid from the State Projects Fund.
8. The Community Project Grant Fund shall each year receive only the amount allocated for approved projects in that year, i.e. no funds to be carried over from year to year.

*(Update July 2015: At the 91st State Conference the following motion was carried: Preamble - Because some branches do not have the capacity to achieve small renovations or projects for their Restrooms, it is moved that: "The eligibility criteria for CWA of WA Community Projects Grant Applications be expanded to include CWA of WA Centres".)
