



**Instructions: CLOTHES ( knit ) for: CALICO DOLL**

(Project via CWA of WA Community Co-ordinator (March 2021))

Note: if 6 months have passed since the above date, please check that this item is still required before you begin.

***Calico Doll Clothes patterns -8ply wool, 9 or 3 ¼ needles, 2.50 crochet hook.***

***Beanie***

Cast on 44 stitches and knit garter stitch 20 rows. Next row, stocking stitch and decrease by knitting 2 then knit 2 together to end of row. Next row purl, then knit 1 then knit 2 together. Purl next row. Next row knit 2 together till the end of the row. Purl next row. Then break yarn making sure you have enough yarn to sew up seam and then thread yarn through the stitches and pull together and secure by sewing side seam.

***Boy's shirt***

Cast on 48 stitches and garter stitch for 30 rows. Divide for front and back by knit 24 and put the rest of the stitches on a stitch holder. Next row knit 3 then purl until the last 3 stitches and knit 3. Then knit next row. Repeat the knit 3 then purl until the last 3 stitches and knit 3 followed by a knit row for 18 rows. Then garter stitch rows 19 and 20 creating a border. 21<sup>st</sup> row knit 3, wool forward and knit 2 together to make a hole. Knit to the last 5 stitches. Knit 2 together, wool forward and knit 3. Cast off the next row.

Pick up the remaining 24 stitches and repeat pattern. Crochet 2 ties - 55 chain for each tie. Secure ties to the back by knotting through the hole on each side— so ties don't come lose, and then tie both sides together with a bow over each shoulder.

***Girl's Dress***

Cast on 64 stitches and work 18 rows and either pattern or garter stitch and lace. Then work 16 rows of stocking stitch (34 rows in total). Next row knit 1, then knit 2 together and knit 2, till the end of the row then knit 1 = 48 stitches. Divide and work pattern as for Boys shirt.

***Pants***

Leg 1, cast on 24 stitches and work 14 rows of garter stitch. Leave these 24 stitches on a spare needle. Repeat for Leg 2. Row 15 - knit 24 stitches and then continue knitting the 24 stitches of Leg 1. Garter stitch the next 20 rows. Work a row of ribbon holes by: knitting 1, then wool forward and knit 2 together, to the end of the row. Next row cast off. Sew up the leg seams. Crochet 100 chain for the tie.
