



MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 18cm long x 20cm high.

MATERIALS

8-ply acrylic yarn (50g):

- Two balls yellow
- Small amount orange
- Small amount black, for embroidery
- One pair 4mm (No 8) knitting needles
- One pair 2.75mm (No 12) knitting needles
- Knitter's needle, for sewing seams and embroidery
- Polyester filling
- Ribbon

KNITTING

Note: Before beginning, it is important to read the **Basic Instructions** on page 5.

Approximately
24 rows

WING
make 2

14 stitches

FOOT
make 2

14 stitches

Using 4mm needles and yellow for Wings and orange for Feet, cast on 14 sts. Knit 24 rows, cast off.

Approximately 48 rows

BODY
make 2

28 stitches

Using 4mm needles and yellow, cast on 28 sts. Knit 48 rows, cast off.

Approximately
24 rows

HEAD
make 1

28 stitches

Using 4mm needles and yellow, cast on 28 sts. Knit 24 rows, cast off.

Approximately
12 rows

TAIL
make 1

7 stitches

Using 4mm needles and yellow, cast on 7 sts. Knit 12 rows, cast off.

Approximately
24 rows

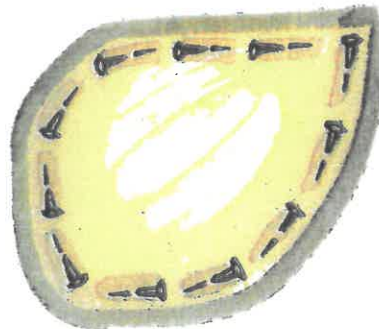
BILL
make 2

14 stitches

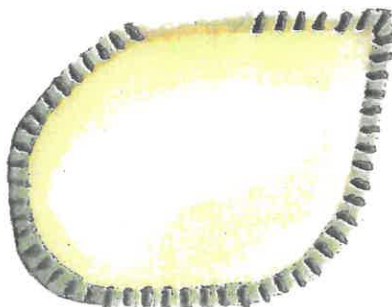
Using 2.75mm needles and orange, cast on 14 sts. Knit 24 rows in stocking stitch (see page 95), cast off.



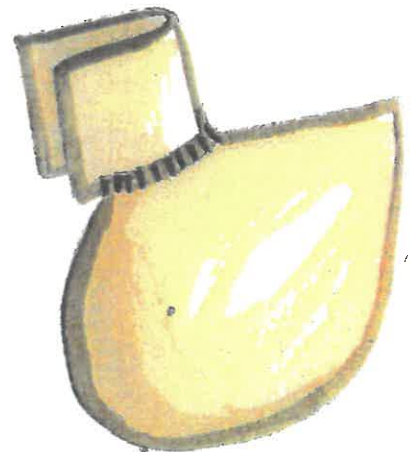
TO MAKE UP



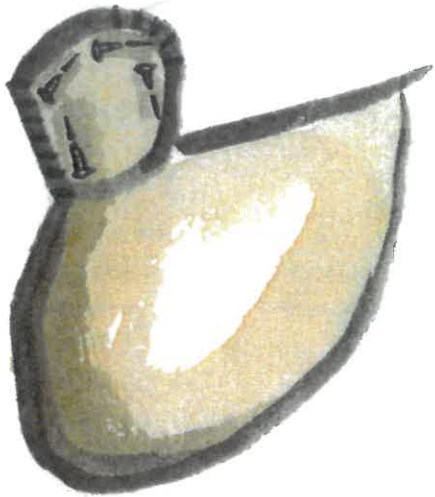
1 Pin Body squares together, folding edges under to create shape shown.



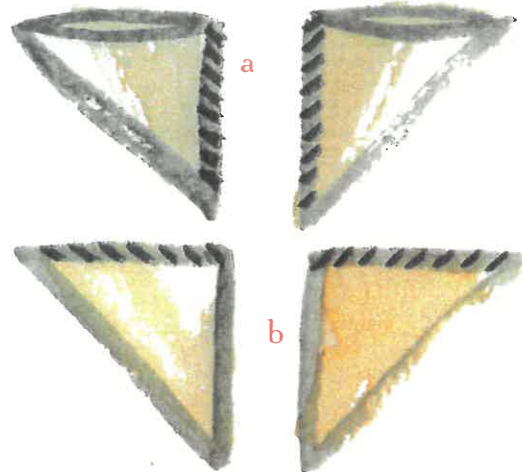
2 Sew around Body, leaving a 6cm neck opening in top seam. Stuff with polyester filling.



3 Fold Head in half widthwise to find centre and mark with pin. Matching pin with top Body seam, join one long side of Head to neck opening.



4 Pin sides of Head together, rounding back corner as shown, and sew, leaving opening for stuffing. Stuff Head, and sew top opening closed.



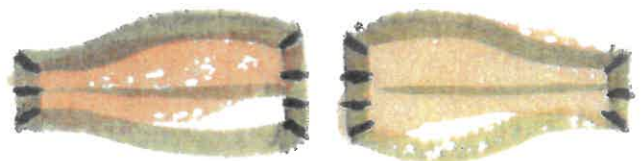
5 Fold each Wing in half diagonally and sew one seam (a). Stuff with polyester filling and sew remaining seam (b).



6 Pin Wings to either side of Body with folded edge uppermost, and sew in place, starting at lowest corner and finishing about 2cm along top edge.



7 Fold each Foot in half and sew side seam to create shape shown.



8 Arrange each Foot so that seam lies in centre, and sew back end closed. Stuff, and sew front end closed.



9 Pin sides of Feet to either side of Body, positioning Feet so that Duck is balanced, and sew in place.



10 Fold Tail piece in half diagonally and sew one seam.



11 Join sewn side of Tail to top back Body.



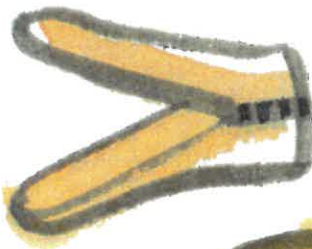
12 Fold each Bill piece in half and sew long seam.



13 Arrange each Bill piece so that seam lies in centre, and sew one end of each piece closed, rounding corners.



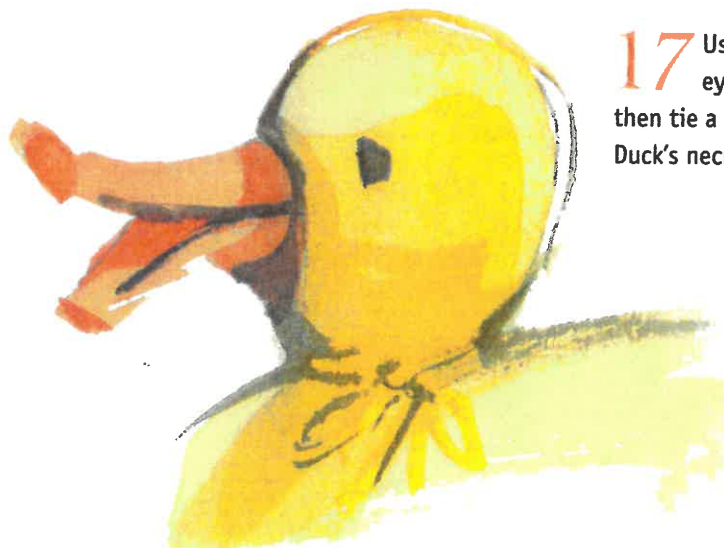
14 Matching centre seams, join Bill pieces together at open ends, to create a tube (a), but leaving half of seam open (b).



15 Fold Bill in half to enclose join, and secure with a few stitches on either side.



16 Position Bill on front of Head and sew in place.



17 Using black, work eyes in satin stitch, then tie a ribbon around Duck's neck to finish.
