



MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 27cm high.

MATERIALS

8-ply acrylic yarn (50g):

- One ball each apricot and grey-brown bouclé
- Small amounts black, grey-brown and red, for embroidery
- One pair 4mm (No 8) knitting needles
- Knitter's needle, for sewing seams and embroidery
- Polyester filling
- Ribbon

KNITTING

Note: Before beginning, it is important to read the Basic Instructions on page 5.



TO MAKE UP



1 Join Front Body and Back Body together along sides, and run a gathering thread around open ends.



2 Pull up gathering to shape Body and sew lower edge closed (seam should be about 10cm long).



Approximately 48 rows

EAR
make 2

14 stitches

Using grey-brown, cast on 14 sts. Knit 24 rows. Change to apricot, knit 24 rows, cast off.



Approximately 48 rows

ARM
make 2
LEG
make 2

14 stitches

Using grey-brown, cast on 14 sts. Knit 38 rows. Change to apricot, knit 10 rows, cast off.

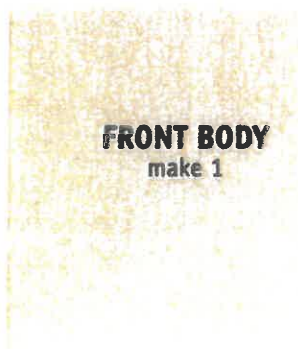


Approximately 96 rows

TAIL
make 1

14 stitches

Using grey-brown, cast on 14 sts. Knit 96 rows, cast off.



Approximately 48 rows

FRONT BODY
make 1

28 stitches

Using apricot for Front Body, and grey-brown for Back Body and Head, cast on 28 sts. Knit 48 rows, cast off.



BACK BODY
make 1
HEAD
make 2

28 stitches

Approximately 24 rows

MUZZLE
make 1

28 stitches

Using apricot, cast on 28 sts. Knit 24 rows, cast off.

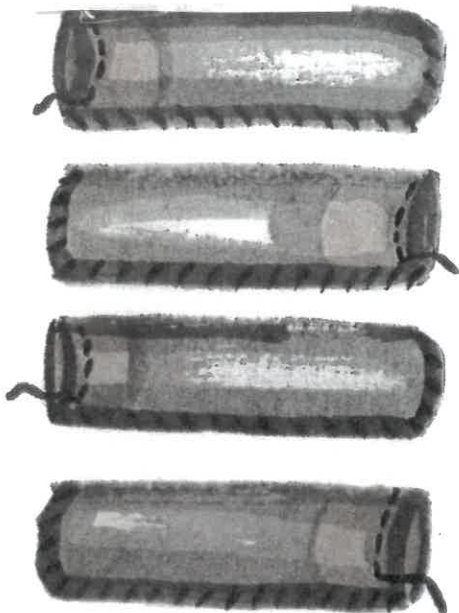
Approximately 24 rows

FACE
make 1

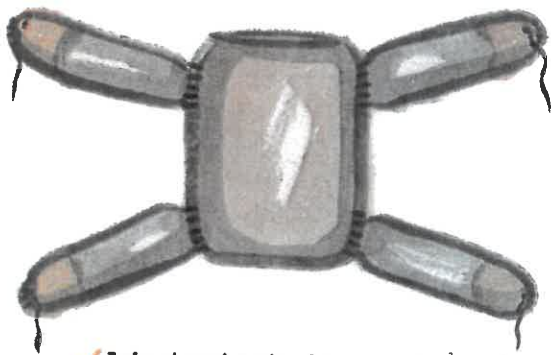
14 stitches

Using apricot, cast on 14 sts. Knit 24 rows, cast off.





3 Fold each Arm and Leg in half widthwise, and join along cast-on edge and long side. Run a gathering thread around open end.



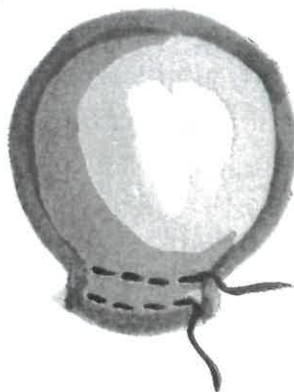
4 Join closed ends of Arms and Legs to Body. Stuff Arms and Legs with polyester filling, pull up gathering at ends and sew openings closed. Stuff Body.



5 Pin Head squares together, rounding corners and shaping neck.



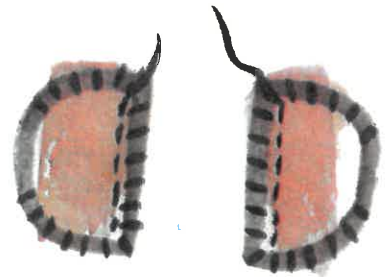
6 Sew around edge, leaving neck edge open for stuffing.



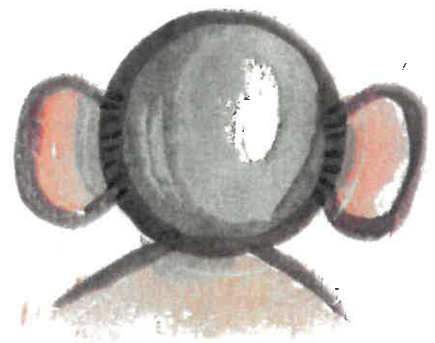
7 Run a gathering thread around neck edge and top of neck. Stuff Head, pull up gathering to approximately 19cm, and stuff neck.



8 Insert neck in Body opening, add more filling to Body if necessary, pull up gathering around neck edge of Body to fit neck, and tie off. Sew neck to neck edge of Body.



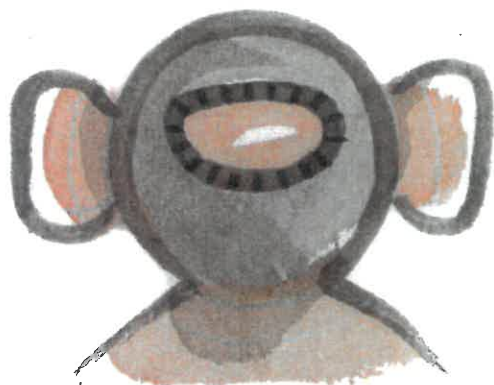
9 Fold each Ear in half along colour change. Sew around three sides, folding in excess along straight side and rounding corners. Run a gathering thread along sewn edge.



10 Pull up gathering slightly and join gathered edge of each Ear to Head seam.



11 Run a circular row of gathering stitches around Face square.



12 Pull Face into oval shape and pin onto top front of Head, folding edges under, then sew in place.



13 Fold Muzzle in half widthwise, sew upper seam and run a gathering thread around one open end.

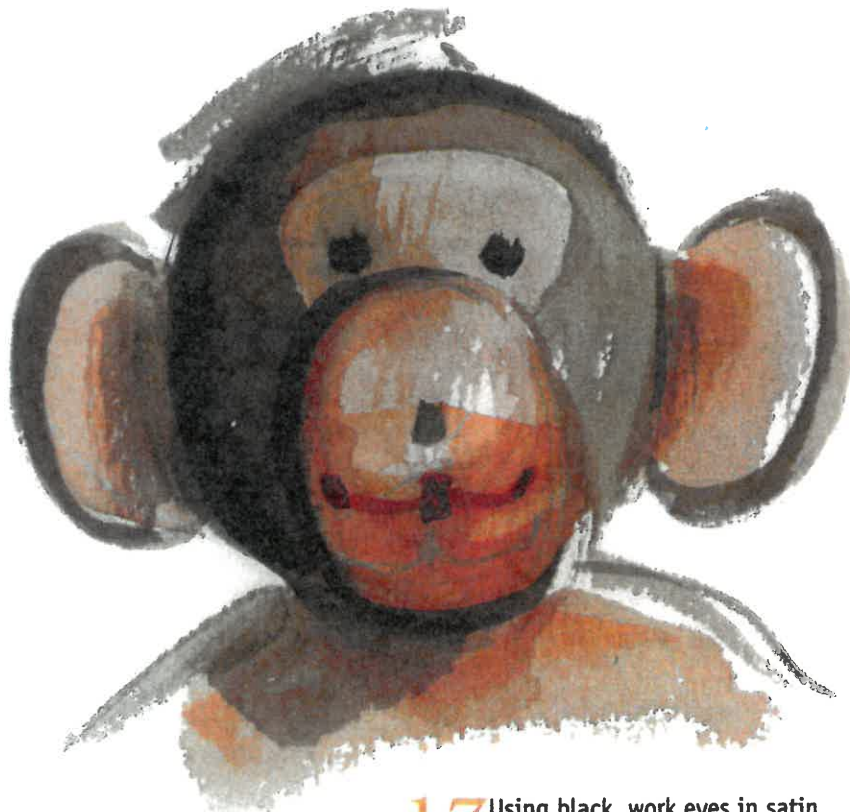


14 Pull up gathering tightly and tie off. Stuff Muzzle.



15 Position Muzzle on Head, overlapping Face slightly, and sew in place.

16 Fold Tail in half lengthwise and sew long seam, folding in one end to create a point. Stuff well, sew open end closed and join to lower half of back Body.



17 Using black, work eyes in satin stitch. Using grey-brown, work nose in satin stitch. Using a double red thread, work mouth in straight stitch. Tie a ribbon around Monkey's neck to finish.
