- All study for the TAFE Digital Diploma can be completed online
- Note that TAFE coursework will need to be completed out of business hours (training in clinic is for audiometry practice only)
- The Scholarship runs for a 12 month period with all study to be completed within this time frame
- A laptop and audiological equipment will be made available
- A scholarship recipient will be a part of the Audika Graduate Program Alumni of the year they commence their study with TAFE Digital.

Selection criteria:

- Ability to work full-time clinic hours each week
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Completed either Year 12 equivalent and/or able to apply for TAFE Diploma level study
- Ability to travel within Western Australia initially and Australia to complete training requirements as part of the study program
- Advanced Microsoft Word skills
- Valid Driver's Licence
